### The Flintstones

This term our topic is the Stone Age. We will study how people lived and how they survived. We will look at Stone Age settlements and evidence that can still be found today.

### English and Maths

Our English lessons will be linked to our topic this term. We will be studying looking at the book *The Stone Age Boy*, which we will use to write narratives. We will use the information learnt in our topic lessons to create an information text.

Our focus in Maths this term is multiplication and division. The first part of the term we will concentrate on counting in 3s, 4s and 8s and learning our multiplication and division facts. The second part of the term the focus will be on written methods for multiplication and division.

**Home Learning:** Last term, the home learning was a huge success. The children worked very hard to produce their tasks and I was particularly impressed by the Iron Men. This term, the format will be the same and consist of activities to choose from a grid based around our topic. The children will be responsible for completing a task each week and then bringing them in just before the end of term. We would also welcome as much support in reading with your child at home, learning times tables by heart and practicing mental maths skills too.
